What are Shared Care Plans?

Shared care plans help manage patients with chronic and/or complex health and social needs who are at higher risk of needing acute services.

These plans include:

- [Personalised Care Plans \(PCP\)](#).

They are available on Health Connect South and can be shared widely across health services throughout the South Island.



Why use Shared Care Plans?

Having timely access to relevant health information benefits both patients and healthcare providers. We strongly encourage general practices to leverage shared care plans to share important patient health details efficiently.

How to search for existing acute plans?

Acute plans can be written by various healthcare services, not just your practice. Some of your enrolled patients may already have an acute plan in place.

You can search for existing acute plans using the Acute Plan Search tool.
